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WORKS ON THE 330kV TAKORADI-THERMAL-ANWOMASO TRANSMISSION LINE

Tema, 21st December 2025 --- The Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) wishes to inform the public, particularly residents of Kumasi and surrounding communities, that AKSA Energy is undertaking works to bring its newly constructed power generation plant at Anwomoso, Kumasi, into operation.

The new plant, when fully commissioned, will provide additional generation capacity to serve consumers and significantly improve power supply reliability in Kumasi and adjoining areas. As part of the commissioning process, an exercise is being undertaken today to facilitate the safe connection of the AKSA Anwomoso Generating Plant to the national power system via the 330kV Takoradi-Thermal-Anwomoso Transmission Line.

The activity may, regrettably, require a temporary interruption in power supply to some customers for approximately three (3) hours to enable the safe termination and integration of the new substation. Power supply to all affected customers is expected to be fully restored by 11:00p.m. today.

GRIDCo sincerely apologises for any inconvenience this interruption may cause and assures the public that the works are necessary to enhance the stability and reliability of power supply in all the affected areas.

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Note to Editors:

Ghana Grid Company Limited (GRIDCo) was incorporated in December 2006 to carry out the economic dispatching and transmission of electricity from facilities of wholesale suppliers (Independent Power Producers [IPPs]) to bulk customers and distribution utilities in Ghana and West Africa. The Company became operational on August 1, 2008, following the transfer of the Transmission System Department and its core staff from VRA to GRIDCo. It operates the National Interconnected Transmission System (NITS). GRIDCo currently transmits electricity to thirty-one (31) Bulk Customers and Distribution Utilities from eleven (11) Wholesale Suppliers, including the Volta River Authority (VRA).

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
