EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE WORK AT SMELTER II SUBSTATION, TEMA

Tema 26th May, 2026 --- The Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) wishes to inform the general public that it will undertake urgent maintenance works at the Smelter II Substation in Tema on Wednesday, 27th May 2026, as part of ongoing efforts to strengthen power supply reliability and enhance the resilience of the transmission network.

As a result of the maintenance works, some customers and residents within parts of Tema may experience a temporary interruption in electricity supply from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, 27th May 2026.

GRIDCo regrets the inconvenience this essential maintenance exercise may cause and assures the public that its engineers and technical teams will work diligently to complete the works within the shortest possible time and restore power supply promptly.

Ghana Grid Company LTD. (GRIDCo) was incorporated in December 2006 to carry out the economic dispatching and transmission of electricity from facilities of wholesale suppliers (Independent Power Producers [IPPs]) to bulk customers and distribution utilities in Ghana and West Africa. The Company became operational on August 1, 2008, following the transfer of the Transmission System Department and its core staff from VRA to GRIDCo. It operates the National Interconnected Transmission System (NITS). GRIDCo currently transmits electricity to thirty-one (32) Bulk Customers and Distribution Utilities from eleven (11) Wholesale Suppliers, including the Volta River Authority (VRA).
